The feedback from residents and staff has been extremely positive, and we are looking forward to welcoming Pete back again soon.

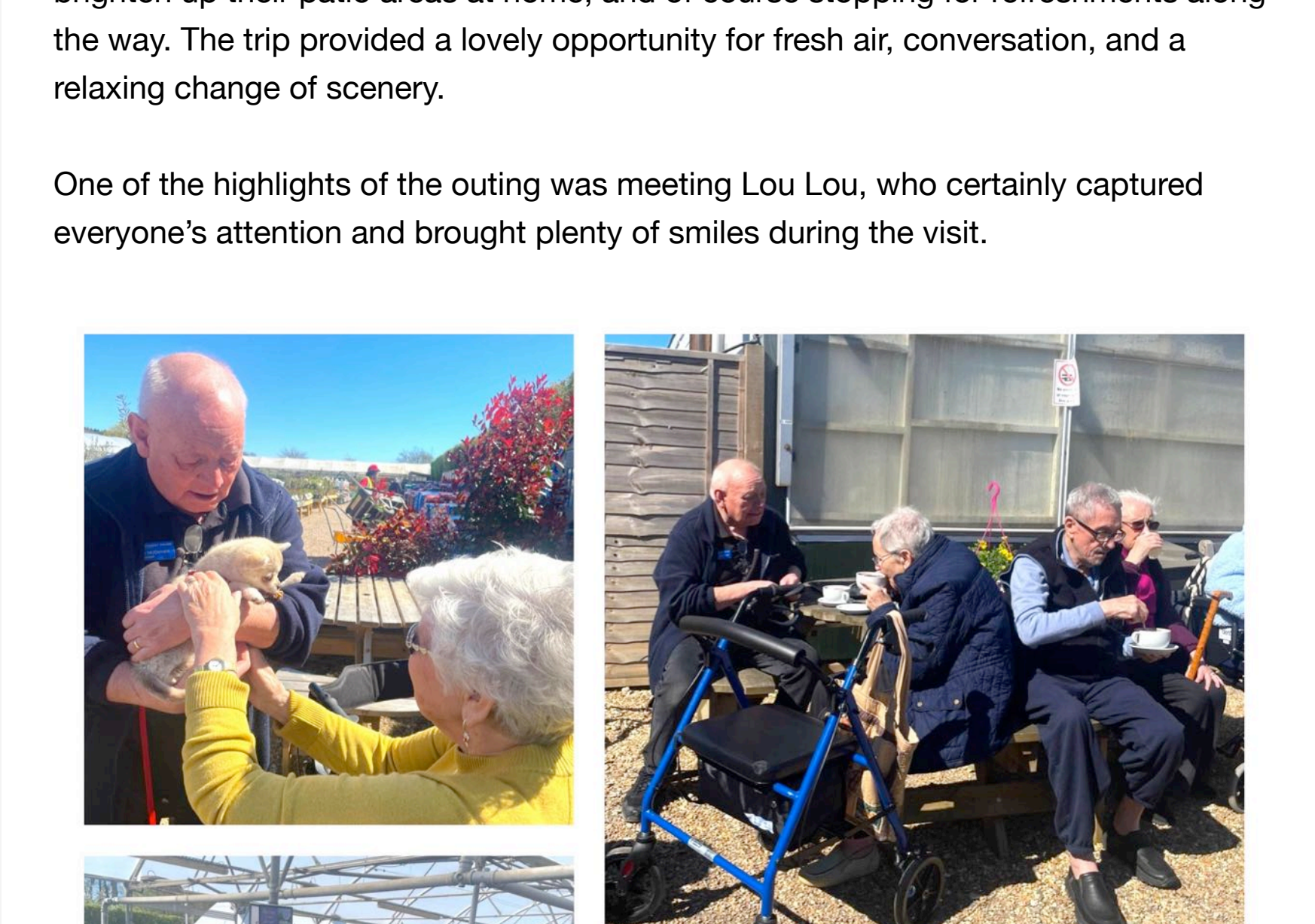


Sunny Days at the Garden Centre

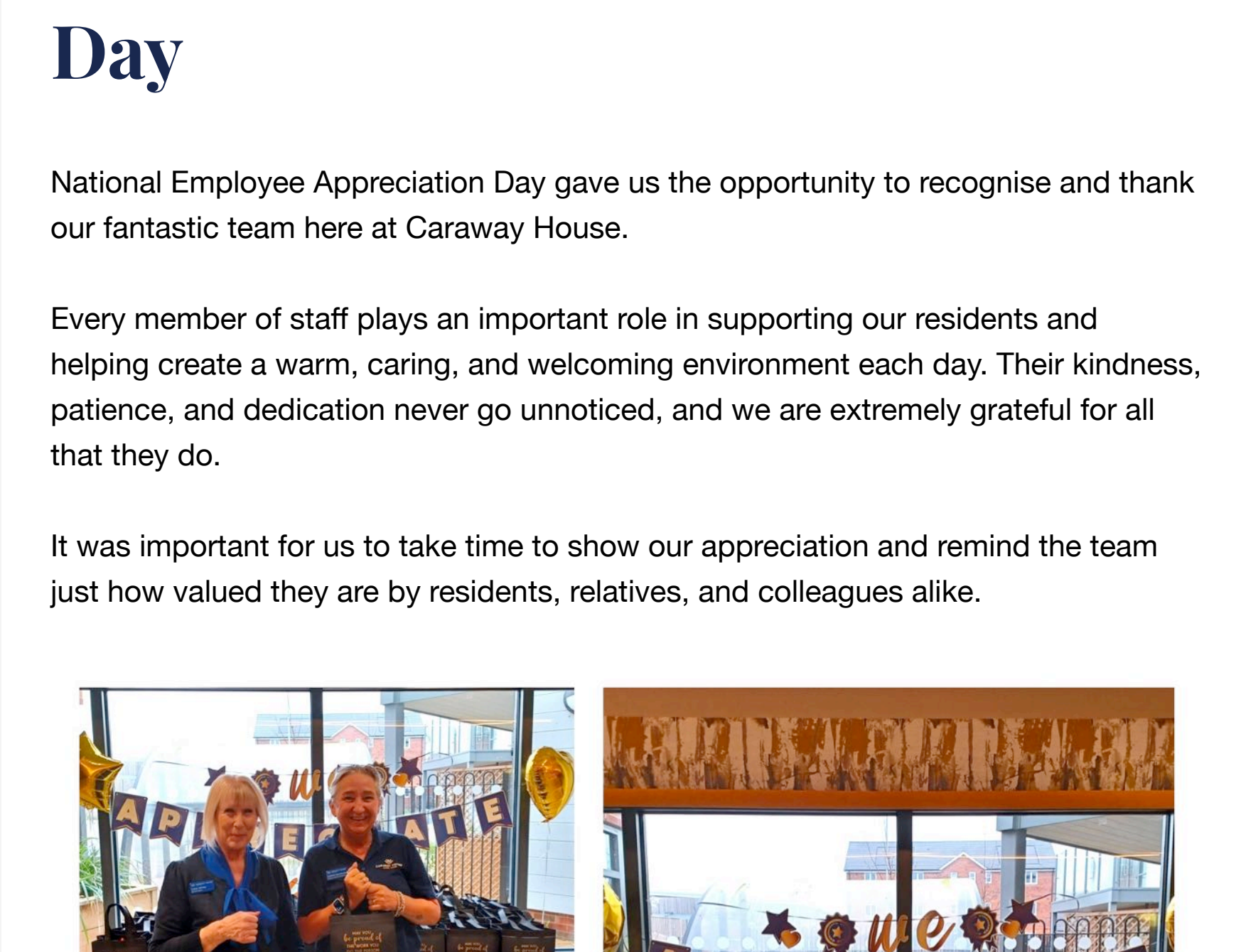
STAFF CORNER
